WHAT'S NEW

We are glad to announce that we are now accepting a wide variety of private insurance and Private Fee For Service (PFFS) plans. PFFS plans are also known as Medicare Advantage (MA) plans and are offered by a state licensed risk bearing entity, which has a yearly contract with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to provide beneficiaries with all their Medicare benefits plus any additional benefits the company decides to provide. A major difference between PFFS Medicare Advantage Organization (MAO) and other MAOs is that, in most cases, people who join a PFFS MAO are not required to use a network of providers. Beneficiaries can see any provider who is eligible to receive payment from Medicare and agrees to accept payment from the PFFS MAO.
